

## Stonegate subdivision receives CONA grant

The Stonegate-Homestead Neighborhood Association received a \$250 grant from the Council of Neighborhood Associations (CONA) of Woodford County. The grant money will be used to improve the entrance to Stonegate subdivision. A 2020 CONA of Woodford County grant for \$250 helped fund a new sign for the Stonegate entrance. The 2021 grant will be used to fund lighting the entrance to improve safety and visibility, as well as improve the identity of Stonegate subdivision. Stonegate subdivision's sign was destroyed many years ago and was not replaced until the Stonegate-Homestead Neighborhood Association made it a priority project for the community.
